


8-BEAR PAW

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric A

4 - 5 1/4" x 5 1/4"

1 - 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"


Fabric B

4 - 5 1/4" x 5 1/4"

1 - 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"


Collect your cut fabrics.

Draw diagonal lines across the backs of the 5 1/4" light colored squares, from one corner to the other.



Place a light square on top of a dark square, right sides together.

Stitch on the line.




Trim away one side, leaving a quarter inch seam allowance.

Open, pressing seam allowance towards the dark.

Repeat for remaining three sets.


Square up the four squares to 4 1/2".



Arrange all the units into a bear paw shape.

Stitch the two side units together, using a 1/4" seam allowance.

Stitch the top three units together.



Stitch the two side units to the large square.

Stitch the bottom to the top.

Your block is complete!
